Sød Is Løvæ

God, apart from having the capacity to love (and in fact has loved humanity with eternal love), has the quality of being love Himself.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. John 3:16

He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. 1 John 4:8



The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee. Jeremiah 31:3

Exalt the LORD our God, and worship at his holy hill; for the LORD our God is holy. Psalms 99:9

In God there is no moral or any other kind of corruption. From Him comes all separation from uncleanness and sin. Therefore, God does not like corruption. He dwells in holiness.

Sød Is Just

"He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he."

God knows how to give each one his due. He does not overlook wickedness and rewards the one who has done good.

God, in His dealings, shows no partiality; He does not mistreat others; perfectly execute revenge against the oppressors. God is just in the fulfillment of rewards and punishments.

Justice and righteousness, which always go hand in hand, are the

Cod Is Faithful

And, ye masters, do the same things unto them, forbearing threatening: knowing that your Master also is in heaven; neither is there respect of persons with him. Ephesians 6:9

Sød Is Incompanable



In our attempt to understand God, we must start from the basis that there is nothing and no one to which we can compare to Him. God is above all, He is sovereign over everything and He is the judge of all.

To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? saith the Holy One. Lift up your eyes on high, and behold who hath created these things, that bringeth out their host by number: he calleth them all by names by the greatness of his might, for that he is strong in power; not one faileth. Isaiah 40:25-26

For who in the heaven can be compared unto the LORD? who among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto the LORD? God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about him. O LORD God of hosts, who is a strong LORD like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee? Psalms 89:6-8

Sød Is Patient

Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance? Romans 2:4

And therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him. Isaiah 30:18

God doesn't get angry quickly. Instead, He waits patiently, giving people a chance to turn from their evil ways. He is patient with you when it comes to your sanctification and your relationship with him and with others.

And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth.

The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to usward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

Sød Is Jødløus



The root of this word means "to blush very intensely" because of a deep emotion such as love, jealousy, or anger.

Only God is worthy of worship. He does not tolerate the worship of anyone but Himself. God refuses to share His glory with idols. The worship and service of a divided heart, He declines.

Sød Is Craatør

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
