




GOD HEARS YOU, ANSWERS YOU, AND GIVES YOU SPECIAL REVELATIONS

Daniel is an example of this. During his youth, he did not hesitate to exalt the name of the Most High, and even in his old age, the Lord continued to bless him.



It was while in his bed that the Lord revealed to Daniel the future of the world in response to the anxieties of the old prophet (who, although he was an old man, was not retired to God).

Daniel says: "Then he said to me, 'Daniel, do not be afraid, for from the first day that you disposed your heart to understand and to humble yourself in the presence of your God, your words were heard; and because of your words I have come'" (Daniel 10:12).

Isn't that wonderful? God hears you. It doesn't matter if you are no longer important to society, you matter to God. You must only cling to your Lord.




GOD HAS GIVEN YOU WISDOM THAT YOU MUST SHARE

In 2 Chronicles 10, we find the story of Rehoboam, the son of Solomon.


When the people came to ask him to relieve them of the burden their father had placed on them, he asked the elders who served his father for advice.

Joshua




As an old man, Joshua gathered all the tribes of Israel to give them his last counsel and warnings.

He reminded them of the way God had led His people in the past, right up to the present moment.

He urged them to take God's side by serving Him with integrity and truth, forsaking false gods.

Joshua ended his speech by assuring that he and his household would serve God, and urging them to follow his example:

«And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. » (Joshua 24:15).



Senior women were also of great importance to God; for He did not abandon them to their fate.

The Bible tells us of Naomi, a woman who to society, was a simple old widow who had met a sad end.

But the Lord, in His mercy, granted her the love and faithfulness of Ruth, who became like a daughter to this lonely mother.

If you, like Naomi, are only embittered and others consider you of little value, remember that you are of great value to the Lord, and He can turn your sorrows into joy. Ask Him and He will give you what you need.

You are important to God, and you belong to His family.

Another woman distinguished by heaven was Anna.

The Bible tells us that she was eighty-four years old as a widow, and that night and day she served in the temple.

These few qualities tell us that this woman did not allow the loss of her husband to prevent her from working for God, and the Lord gave her the gift of being able to know the One who would save the world. «And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem. » (Luke 2: 38).

Heaven did not reject the self-sacrificing work of this servant of God. She served in the temple despite her age. The Lord accepted what her physical strength allowed her to do.

What work or activity can you do? Value your efforts; you have much to give; Don't limit yourself because you lack the energy of youth.

TRUST GOD WHOLEHEARTEDLY AND MOVE FORWARD BY FAITH ACCOMPLISHING


YOUR MISSION
