This woman is an example of leadership from childhood and throughout her life. But what could she tell us about her own story?






What a beautiful, important and at the same time overwhelming task was entrusted to you. Did you ever feel like it was too much for you?


#### Can you tell us the amazing story that split your life in two?

















#### Didn't you feel afraid of the consequences that this could bring you?

Barak and I sang a beautiful song of praise, which to this day rings in the ears of many. We declare, before all the people, that God is the only one who deserves praise, honor and glory.





What was it that your husband did that provoked so much anger


in Dauid, the future king of Israel?


My husband Nabal had a selfish and petty character that led him to make a terrible mistake against the Lord's anointed.

This gave her the strength to face the greatest challenge of her life. Let's get to know her a little more.








# Queen Esther, what was your experience like while living in the largest palace in Persia?


It was a big change in my life to arrive at the King's palace as his wife. I realized that I was taken by God to the exact place where He could use me.

#### **MARY**


#### THE MOTHER




What a great responsibility fell on you! Did you feel prepared being so young?
