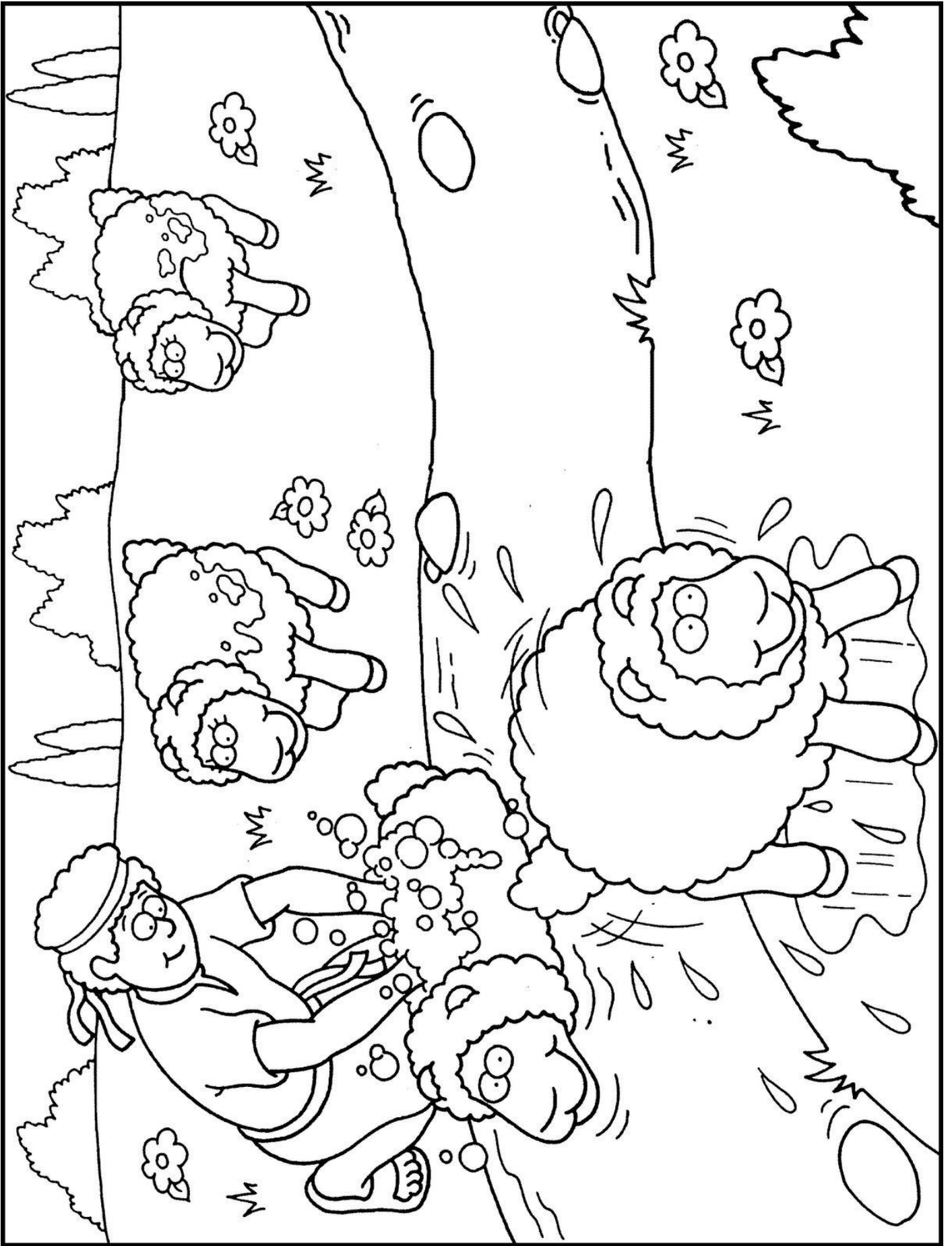
















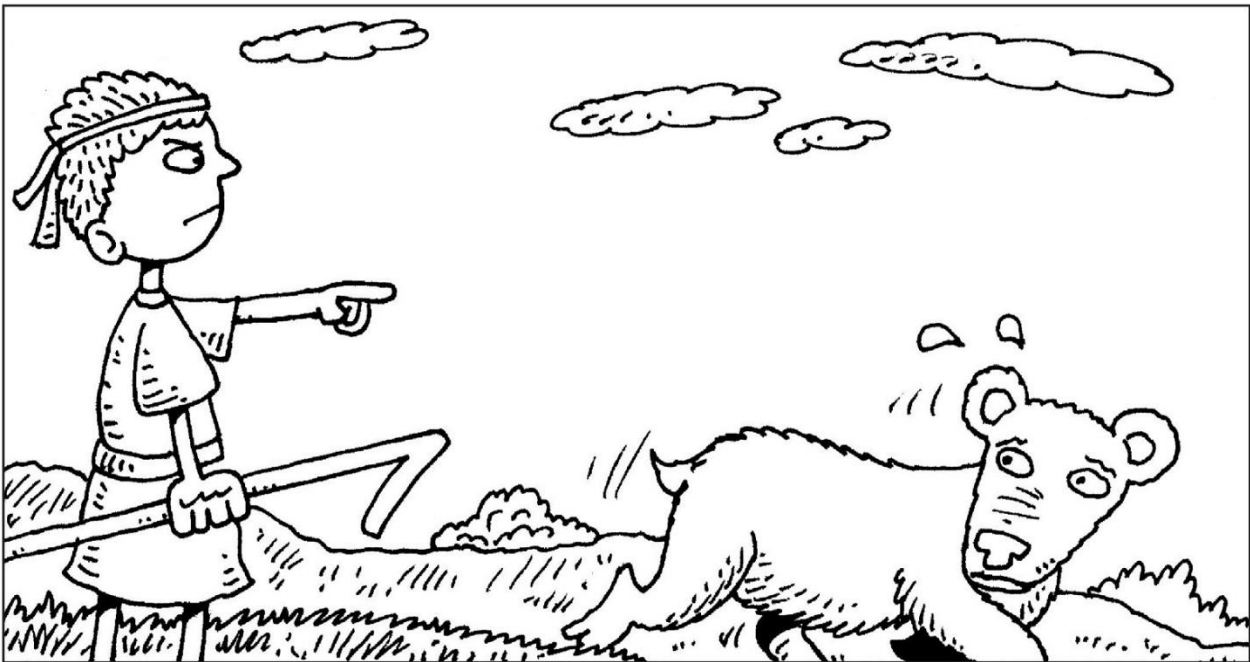


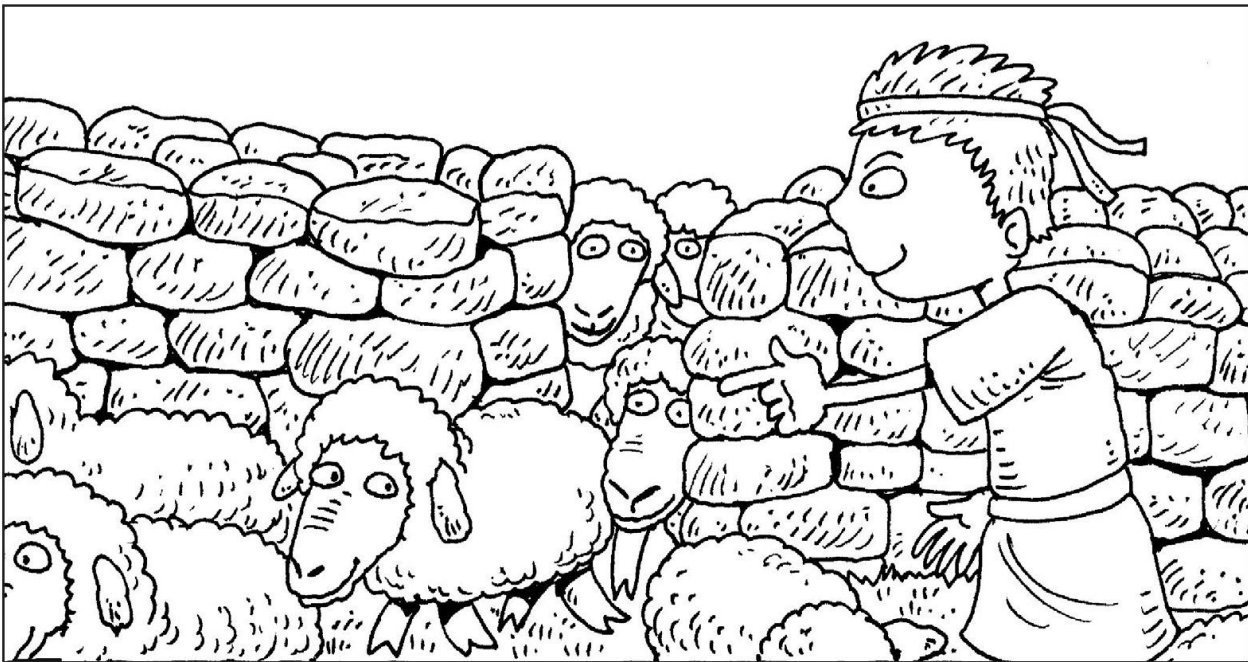












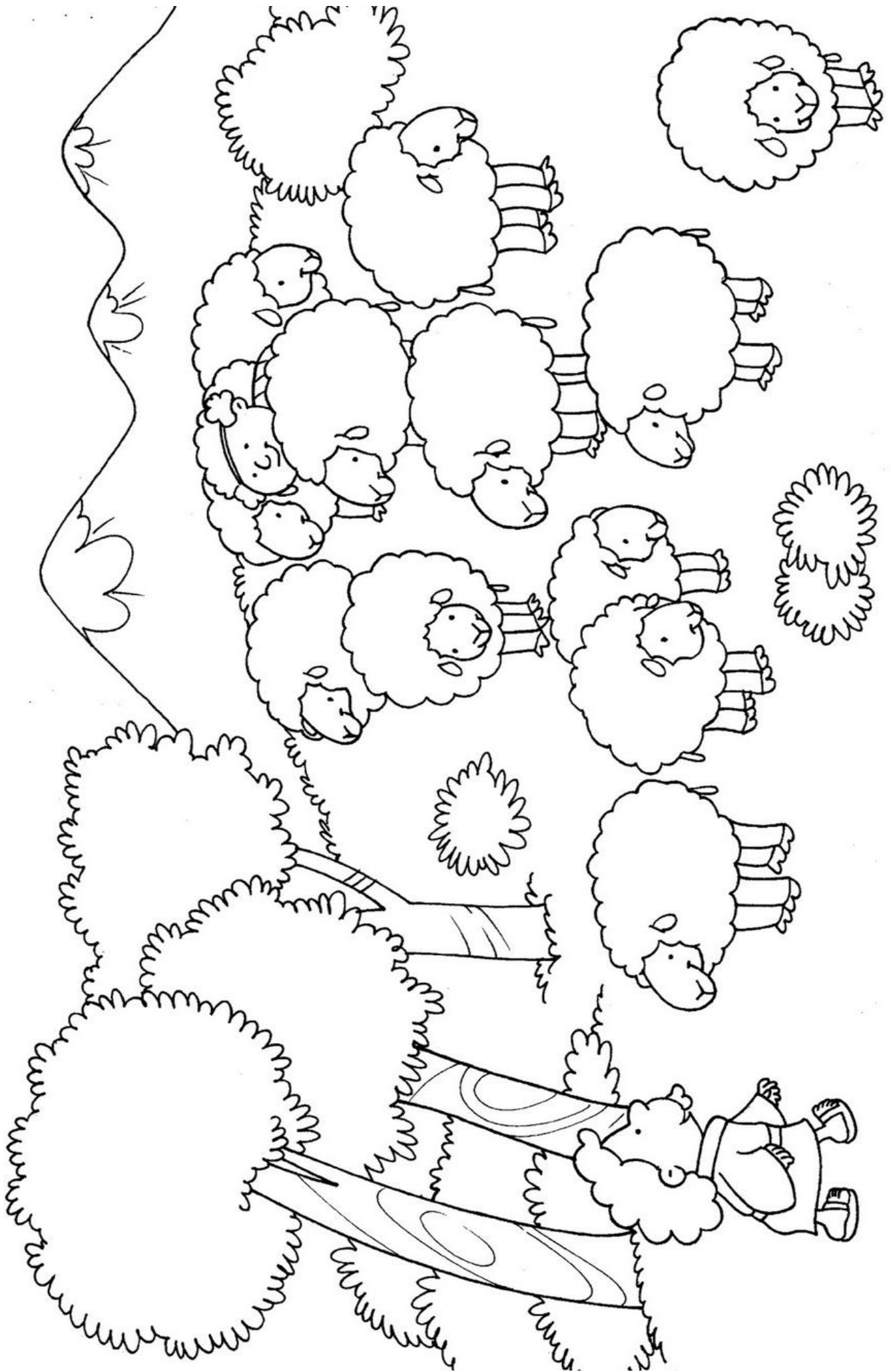


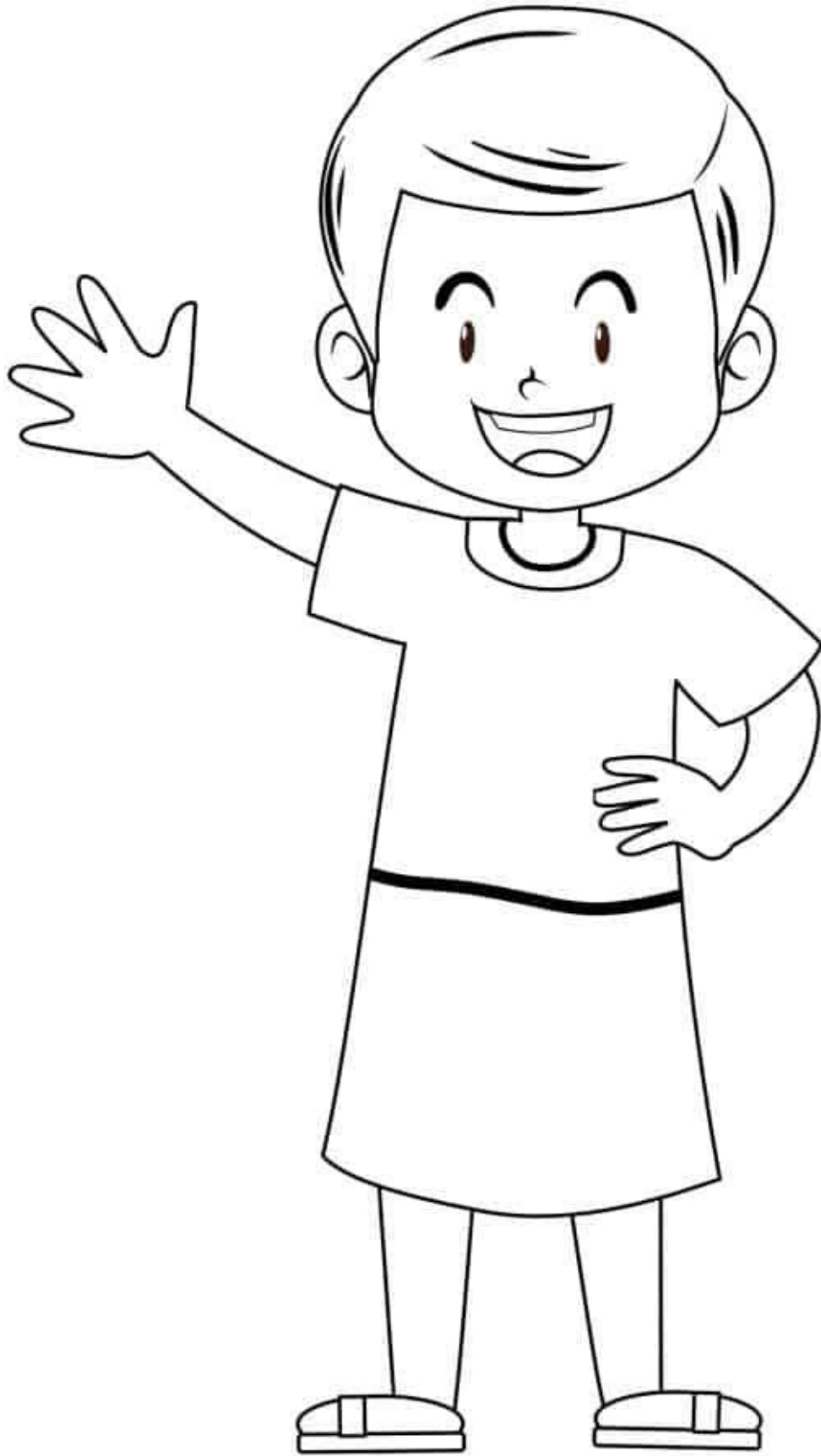


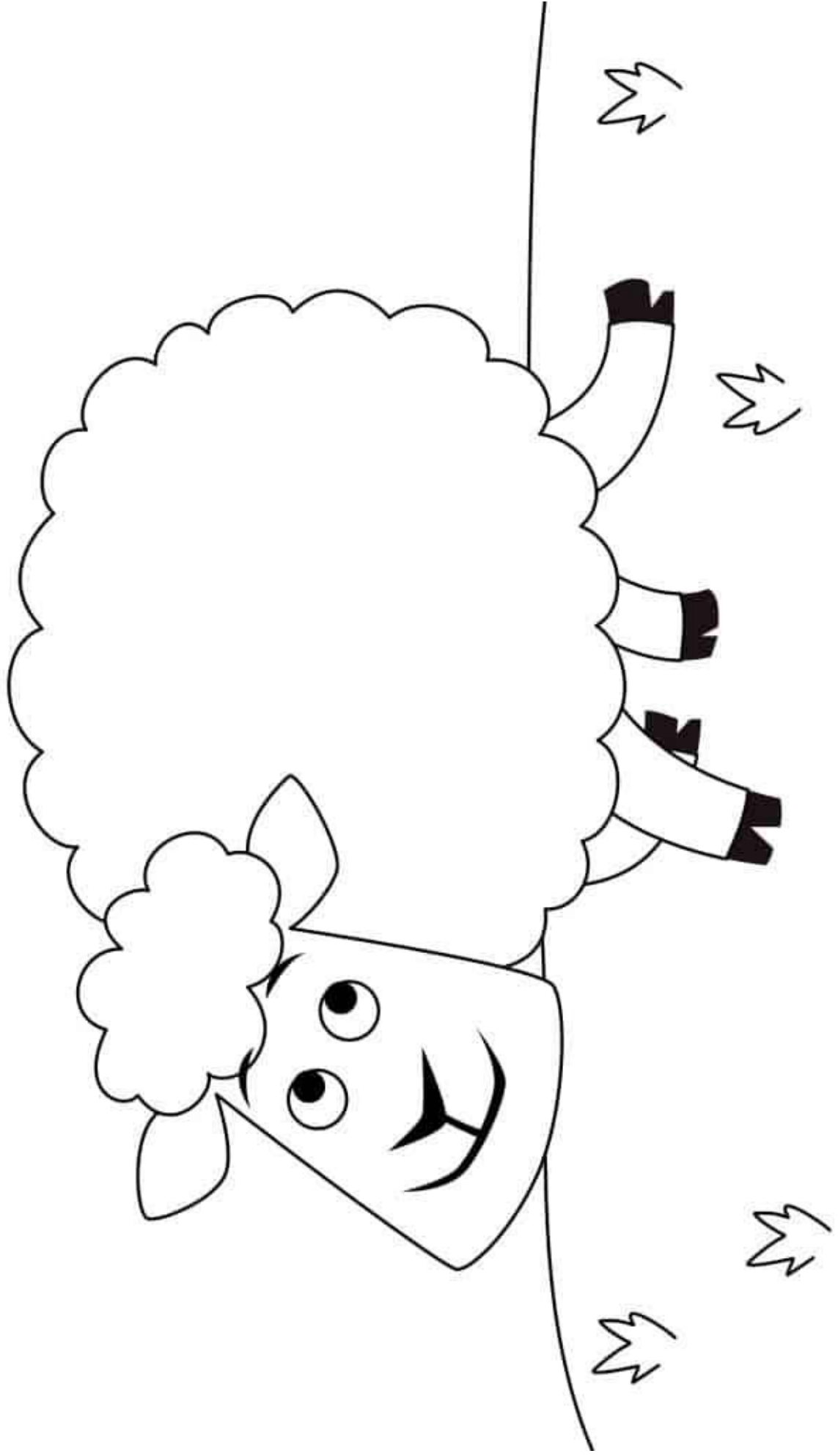






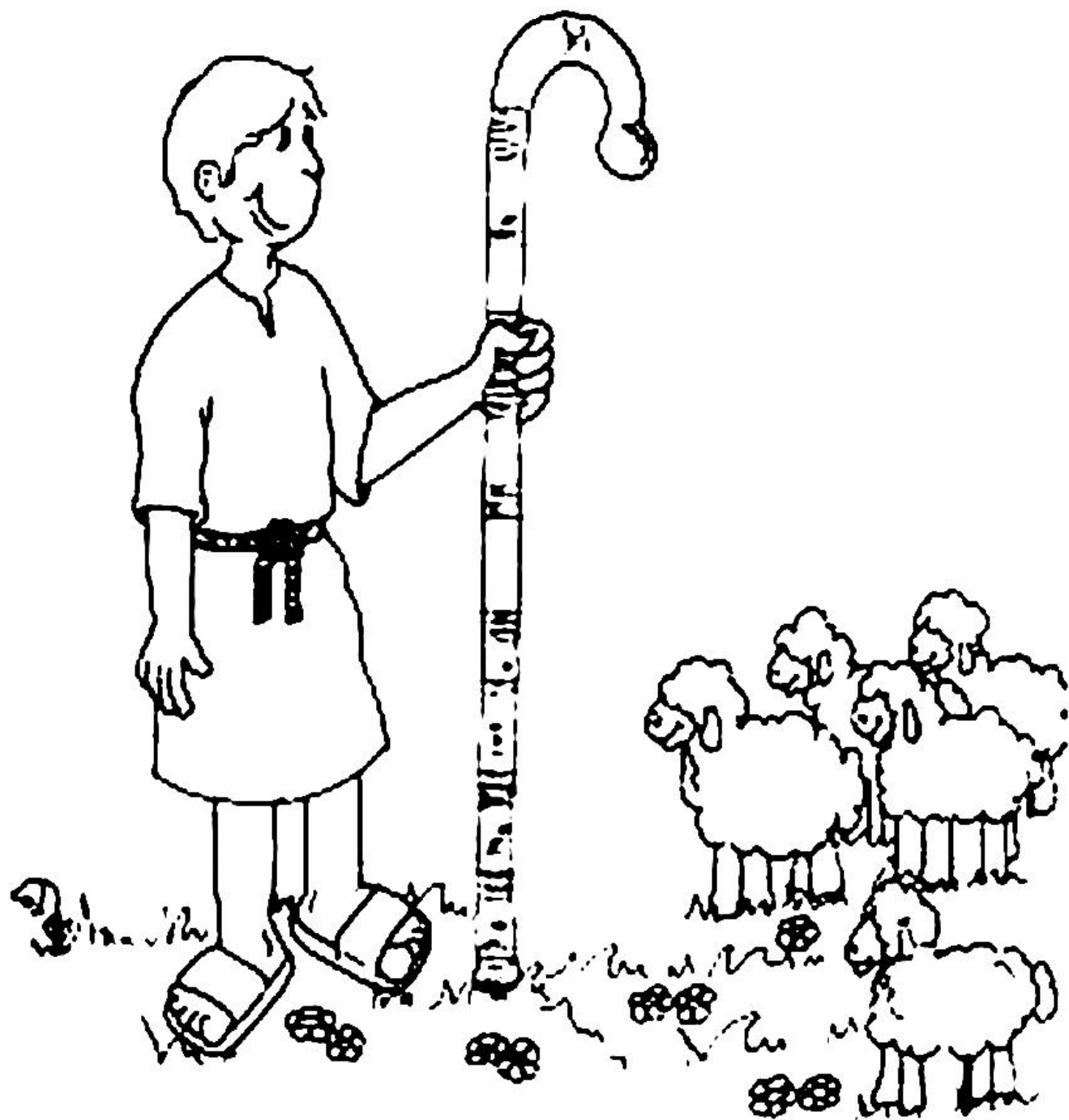








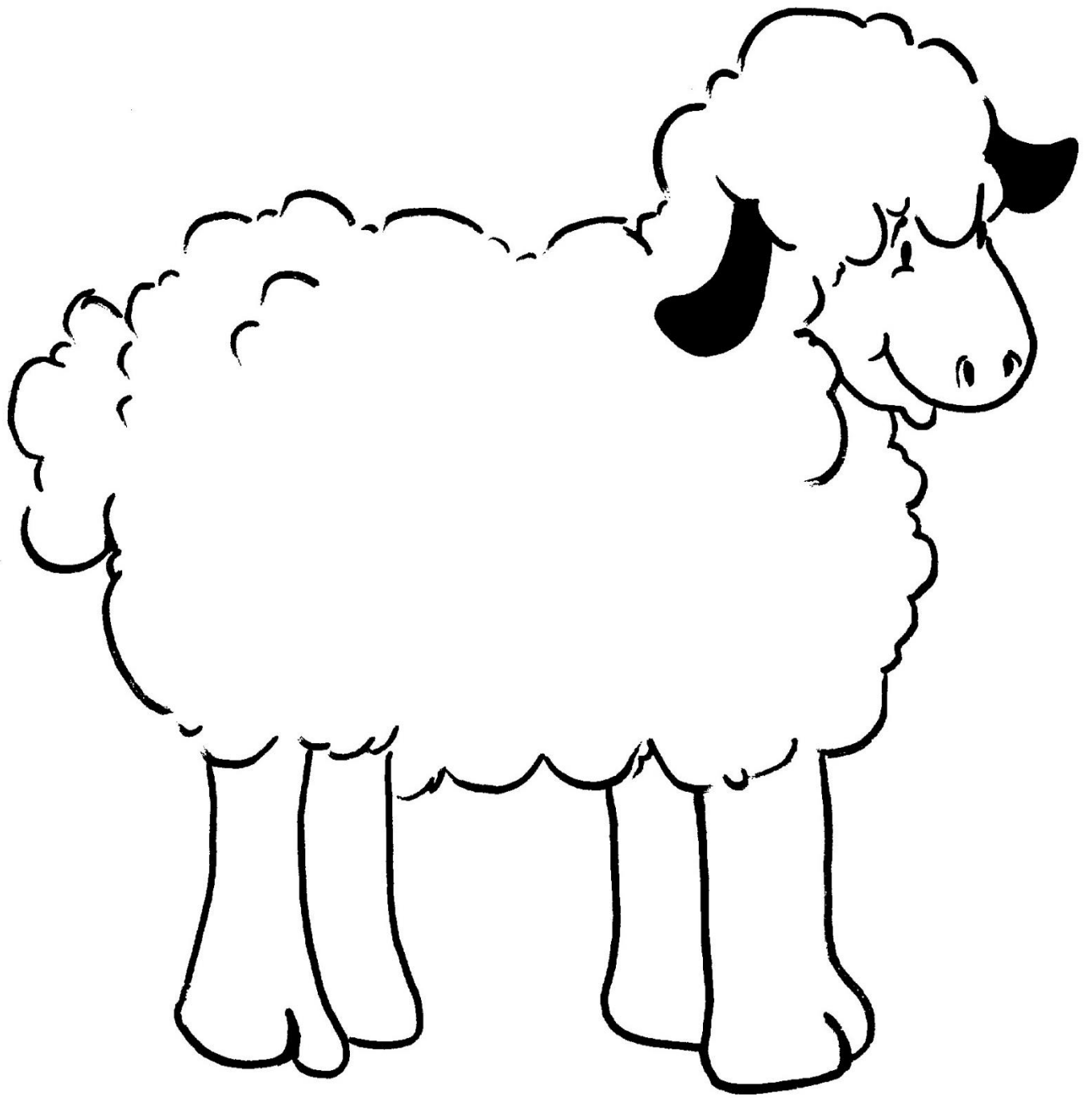


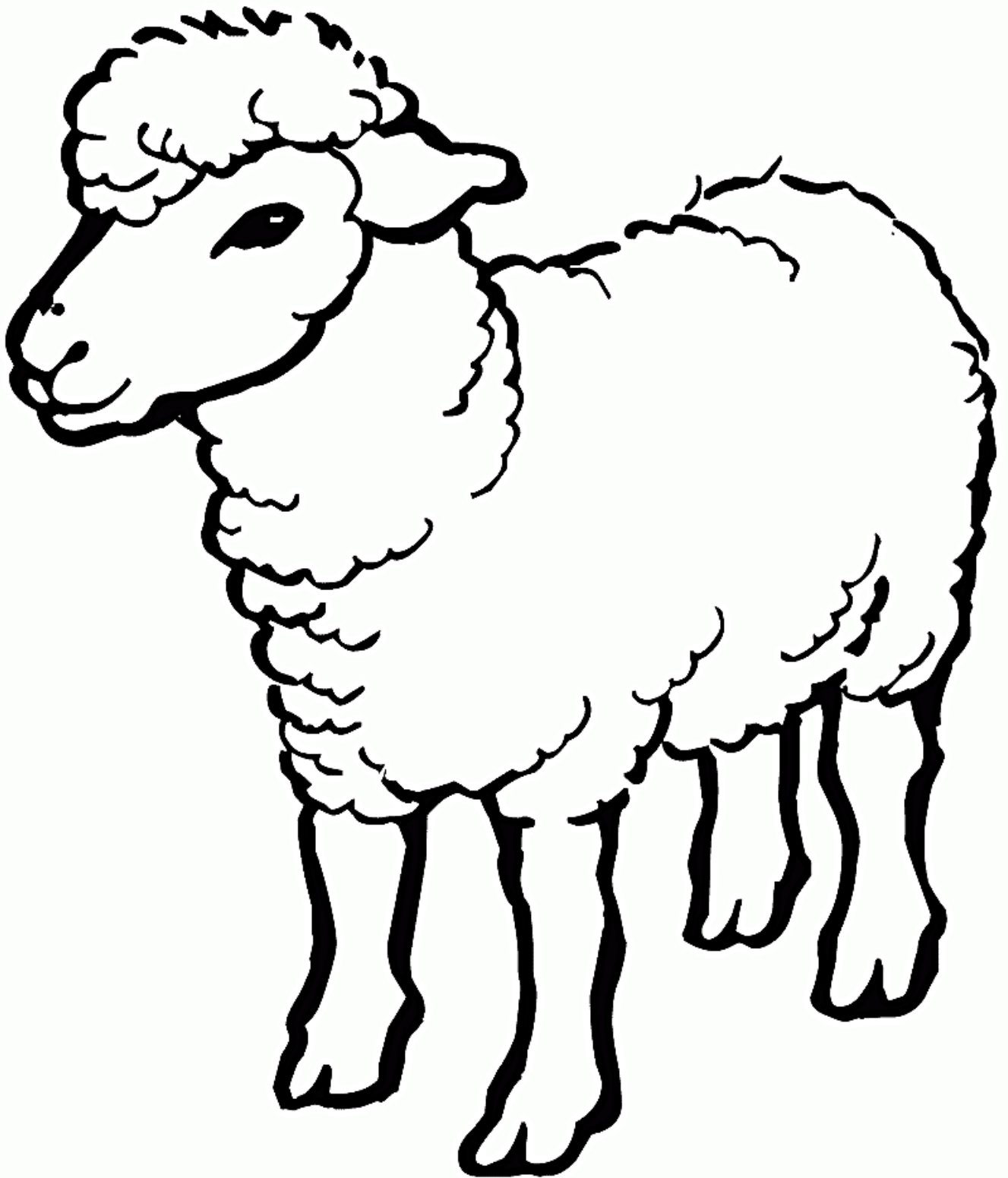












David was a man who loved God very much.
